# **Pre-K (4) & Kindergarten Students:**

- Students will have music class in their classroom, 3 times a cycle for 1 Trimester.
- Students will be actively making music curriculum using the First Steps in Music curriculum by John Feierabend in conjunction with singing, moving and making music using the Orff Schulwerk.
- First Steps utilizes folk songs and rhymes as well as classical music are the primary source materials that are used to develop their musical minds and abilities.

# 1st-3rd Grade Students:

- Students will have music class in their classroom, 3 times a cycle for 1 Trimester.
- The elements of Rhythm, Melody, Timbre, Musical Expression, Form and Harmony will be experienced and developed at each grade level using body percussion, literacy and more!
- In addition to our Orff Schulwerk approach of singing, moving and creating, students will be engage in their music learning using a new resource, Music Play Online!
